Applicant Must:

- Be a female who has completed at least one year of post secondary education or the equivalent by May 31, 2016.
- Be at least 30 years or older.
- Be enrolled for the fall semester of 2016 at an accredited 4 year, 2 year, or higher education program.
- Demonstrate a commitment to educational attainment and a professional career.
- Live or work in Ottawa, Allegan or Muskegon County.
- Have limited financial resources.

To Apply

We encourage those women who meet our qualifications to apply for the Lakeshore ATHENA Scholarship. One or more scholarships are given out each year.
